

Central California Paint Horse Club's  
BREEDERS' CHALLENGE 2016 RULES AND  
REGULATIONS

Both the Sire and Dam of a foal must be listed with the CCPHC-BC committee according to the following rules and regulation before said foal is eligible for entry in the Breeders' Challenge Futurities.

**In the instance of surrogate breeding, the mare must be nominated for each embryonic transplant for any or all resulting foals to become eligible for entry in the Breeders' Challenge Futurities.**

1. **STALLION LISTING:**

- A. Stallion nomination fees are accepted ONLY for the year the foal is born.  
Nomination fee schedule is as follows:  
\$100 through March 31, 2016  
\$125 April 1 thru August 31st  
\$150 September 1 thru day prior to the futurity  
(Cash or Certified Check ONLY after Oct. 1 )<sup>st</sup>
- B. If Stallion owner/lessee does not nominate his/her stallion before the first Mare bred to said Stallion has been nominated, Stallion owner/lessee will receive written notice from the CCCPH-BC committee that the first Mare has been nominated and will have 10 days to nominate his/her Stallion as per current fee schedule (\$100). After ten days they will be governed by the above schedule.
- C. If Stallion owner/lessee does not nominate his/her Stallion per rule (1A or 1B), Mare owners must nominate Stallion for \$100 provided they pay by June 1 & after notification that the Stallion owner/lessee have not complied with rule (1A or 1B). After June 1, they will be governed by the following (1. A) schedule:  
\$125 July 1 thru Aug 31<sup>st</sup>  
\$150 Sept 1 thru day prior to the futurity (note-cash or cashiers check only after Oct 1<sup>st</sup>)
- D. After the Mare owner nominates the Stallion; the Stallion owner/lessee CANNOT nominate his/her Stallion that calendar year EXCEPT for his/her own Mares.
- E. Each Mare owner must nominate any Stallion that has not been nominated by the Stallion owner/lessee per rule (1A or 1B) before their foals are eligible to show in the CCPHC-BC futurities.
- F. The Stallion owner/lessee purse can ONLY be collected by Stallion owner/lessee who have nominated their Stallion per rule (1A or 1B). Each Mare owner that has nominated a Stallion per rule (1B) can ONLY collect the Stallion purse for their winning foals.
- G. If a Stallion is leased, agreement must be approved and on file with the APHA office and a copy of such agreement must be forwarded to the CCPHC-BC committee each year the Stallion is listed.
- H. CCPHC-BC Committee will have the final decision on any special circumstances.
- I. There will be no substitutions, transfers or refunds on Stallion Nomination Fees!



2. **MARE LISTING:**

A. In the instance of surrogate breeding, the mare must be nominated for each embryonic transplant for any or all resulting foals to become eligible for entry in the Breeders' Challenge Futurities.

B. Mare nomination fees are accepted ONLY for the year the foal is born (NO Exceptions).

Nomination fee schedule is as follows:

\$50. thru March 31, 2016

\$75. April 1 thru August 31<sup>st</sup>

\$100 September 1 thru day prior to the futurity.

(Cash or Certified Check ONLY after Oct. 1 )<sup>st</sup>

C If Stallion owner/lessee does not nominate his/her Stallion per rule (1A or 1B), Mare owners must nominate Stallion for \$100 provided they pay before June 1<sup>st</sup> - after notification that the Stallion owner/lessee have not complied with rule (1A or 1B). After June 1, they will be governed by the following schedule:

\$125 June 1 thru<sup>st</sup> Aug 31

\$150 September 1<sup>st</sup> thru day prior to the futurity.

(Cash or Certified Check ONLY after Oct. 1 )<sup>st</sup>

D. All leased Mares MUST have a copy of the APHA lease on file with the CCPHC-BC.

E. Only Mares serviced by listed Stallion are eligible for nomination.

F. Once the Mare and Stallion nominations have been PAID IN FULL, then the resulting foal will be eligible to enter in one or all the following listed Futurities, with breeding stock foals shown with colored foals on an equal basis in all CCPHC-BC Futurities. Foal will not be allowed to enter until all fees (nomination, entry, etc.) are paid in full.

Weanling Halter Futurities for Colt/Geldings and Fillies - Early & Late

(Early = Jan. 1-March 15 Late= March 16 & after

Yearling Halter Futurities for Colts, Geldings and Fillies

Yearling Lunge Line

Two-Year Old English and/or Western Pleasure Futurities

NOTE: ENTRY FEE WILL BE RETURNED IF MARE HAS NOT BEEN NOMINATED.

G. Of Importance - an eligible foal is NOT REQUIRED to show in a subsequent futurity to remain eligible for any of the remaining futurities. There will be no additional fees, except futurity entry fees, to remain eligible for the Yearling and 2 Yr Old Futurities.

1 All APHA registered foals of nominated stallions and mares are eligible for these Futurities. Breeding stock foals will be shown with the colored foals and judges will be advised to judge them on equal basis.

2 **THERE WILL BE NO SUBSTITUTIONS, ADVANCEMENTS OR REFUNDS ON MARE NOMINATIONS, NO EXCEPTIONS!** Mare owners may check on listed Stallions at:

5. All participants will be required to show ORIGINAL REGISTRATION PAPERS prior to entering gate.
6. Futurity Entry Fees are \$150.00
  - A. The \$150.00 entry fee will be paid as follows:  
\$75.00-due September 1<sup>st</sup>      \$75.00-due October 1<sup>st</sup>
  - B. A 100% penalty will be assessed for all late payments.
  - C. NO REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE GIVEN.
  - D. Entry fees may be paid at any time prior to the due dates. After the due dates, penalties will be assessed. Postmark date from the United States Post Office on the envelope will be the determining factor as whether a payment is late.
7. An entry must be exhibited in all go-rounds of their respective futurity to be eligible to receive payback monies.
8. The CCPHC-BC Futurity office will be open prior to each futurity for issuing numbers and checking papers. Late entries will be accepted until show office closes the day prior to the futurities. NO EXCEPTIONS.
9. RETURNED CHECKS WILL NOT BE REDEPOSITED AND WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. To reinstate eligibility, the payer must submit a Cashiers Check or Money Order under the nomination schedule in effect based on the new Post Office postmark date plus a **\$100.00** service charge for the returned check. If payer does not reinstate, the service charge is still due and payable and eligibility/nomination will be restricted until payments are made. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.
10. It will be MANDATORY for each person earning money to give their Society Security Number to the CCPHC-BC committee before any prize money will be issued. If CCPHC-BC does not have your social security number, you will not be issued any monies.
11. Prize monies will be paid to the current owner or the person paying the nomination fees of each entry. If the person receiving monies is other than the current owner or lessee, written permission must be given in writing to the CCPHC-BC committee.
12. Weanling Halter, Yearling Halter Futurities, Yearling Lounge Line, and 2-Year Old Pleasure Futurities will be judged by three or more judges, with these judges being selected from current APHA, AQHA or AHSA judges list, and all scores being used to determine the winner. In the event of a tie score, one judge's score will be used as the tie-breaker to determine the distribution of awards only. Monies will be split evenly in case of all ties. The tie-breaking judge will be selected prior to the futurity.
13. A copy of the registration papers must be submitted with the futurity entry. Weanlings may show with APHA work order, but all monies won will be withheld until copy of Registration Papers are submitted to CCPHC - BC. All paperwork MUST BE RECEIVED BY NOVEMBER 30, or all monies will be forfeited.



14. In each and every CCPHC-BC Futurity, the horses will be placed from first (1<sup>st</sup>) to tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) place and each horse will receive points according to the position in which it is placed under each judge. The point system is as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place=11 Points	5 <sup>th</sup> Place= 6 Points	9 <sup>th</sup> Place= 2 Points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place= 9 Points	6 <sup>th</sup> Place= 5 Points	10 <sup>th</sup> Place= 1 Point
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place= 8 Points	7 <sup>th</sup> Place = 4 Points	
4 <sup>th</sup> Place= 7 Points	8 <sup>th</sup> Place = 3 Points	

15. THE FUTURITIES WILL ALWAYS BE HELD IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND IN CONJUNCTION WITH CCPHC'S FALL SHOW.

16. Payback for the Central Calif Paint Horse Club's Breeders Challenge Futurities and Stallion Owners purse will be as follows:

PAYBACK PERCENTAGES ENTRIES 1-3 entries 100% for first; 4-6 entries pay 1 & 2<sup>nd</sup> places 65% & 35%; 7-10 entries, 3 places, 50%, 30%, 20%; 11-15 entries pays 4 places at 46% ,24% ,17% ,13%; 16-20 entries pay 5 places at 43%,21%,16%,11%, 9% respectively; and 21+entries pay 40%, 20%, 15%, 10% ,8% & 7% respectively.

17. If more than one go is held for a futurity class, the payback will be based on the number of entries in the show ring for the first go-round.

18. By entering this futurity, owners acknowledge the right and give permission for drug testing on any or all entries, randomly or in any manner decided upon by the drug testers.

19. Futurity purses will be paid no later than 30 calendar days after the futurity. The CCPHC-BC reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entry.

20. WPWBC may also disqualify or prohibit exhibitors of entries without claims for damages. ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE CCPHC'S BC COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.

21. The CCPHC-BC will in no case be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to horses exhibited; for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, stolen, destroyed or in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury, or damage done to, or occasioned by or arising from any horses or article owned or exhibited by him/her, and shall indemnify the Central California Paint Horse Club against all legal or other proceedings, claims or demands of any kind or nature in regard thereto, or that may arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse or article.
